Preamble

FIMCAP member organizations agree on this action plan and on having a midterm evaluation at the continental level. Continental bureaus or conferences should report the results back to the ICB.

Awareness raising

- awareness raising and information dissemination to all people
- „Green day“ with different activities on grass root level
- raising awareness in the media
- Activity through games/prepare a workshop day about climate change

Resource sharing

- Each continental conference of FIMCAP produces its respective information package on climate change to be provided in Moodle for all member organisations.
 - o general information about the situation on the continent and the countries where member organisations are located
 - o training materials
 - o games
 - o best practice projects to show how the member organisations work on climate change
 - o methods to work with in the local groups
- Common resources on Moodle (booklets, brochures, workshops)

Green Link/Website

- Link edition with articles, information and games about climate change to support and educate members and leaders to change the situation
- Information on the website especially for children and young people

Eco screening

FIMCAP finds out which organisations already have made an eco screening and collects the know-how and provides it to the member organisations. The member organisations are strongly encouraged to conduct the eco screening process within their organisation and share the results and their experiences.
In three years at least five organisations shall have finished the procedure.

Networking

- The member organisations look actively for cooperation partners (e.g. European Youth Forum, Panafrican Youth Union, Asian Youth Organisation,

Latin American Youth Organisation, EuroMed Youth Platform, UN, FAO, universities, NGOs, GTZ, IFAD...).

- Fimcap supports its member organisations if its reference or contacts are needed.

Food

- We use the regional and ecological food at Fimcap activities and activities of our organisations.
- One vegetarian day on each activity of Fimcap and its member organisations.
- In Europe there is only one meat meal a day served.
- Member organisations which are busy in food production work on the improvement of cultivation methods.

Non-formal education

Participate in already existing local activities on climate change (e.g. tree planting)

Energy

- FIMCAP and its member organisations participate in „Earth Hour“ (possibility to combine it with the „Green day“)
- Member organisations check the production of the energy they use and their energy consumption to promote the use of renewable energy and to save energy
